Sub: Performance Update - half-year ended 30th September, 2010

We would like to apprise you of developments at your Company and its performance during the first half of the current fiscal (H1FY11).

Corporate Developments

(A) Scheme of Amalgamation

The Scheme of Amalgamation of Samruddhi Cement Limited (“Samruddhi”) with your Company (“the Scheme”) has become effective from 1st August, 2010 and is operative from the Appointed Date i.e.1st July, 2010.

In terms of the Scheme, 14,95,33,469 equity shares of ₹ 10/- each have been allotted to shareholders of Samruddhi including the Custodian(s) of the Global Depository Receipts (GDRs).

(B) Acquisition of ETA Star Cement, UAE

Your Company’s wholly owned subsidiary “UltraTech Cement Middle East Investments Limited” (UCMEIL) has completed the acquisition process of ETA Star Cement together with its operations in the UAE, Bahrain and Bangladesh. It has also acquired management control with a 80% beneficial interest.

ETA Star Cement’s manufacturing facilities include a 2.3 mtpa clinkerisation plant and 2.1 mtpa of cement grinding capacity in the UAE, 0.4 mtpa and 0.5 mtpa of cement grinding capacity in Bahrain and Bangladesh respectively. For the acquisition and towards repayment of existing loans, UCMEIL has borrowed US\$ 220 million.

With the amalgamation of Samruddhi and the acquisition of ETA Star Cement, your Company’s capacity stands augmented to 52 mtpa making it the 8th largest cement Company in the world. (Source: BNP Paribas)

Your Company now has 11 integrated plants, one white cement plant, one clinkerisation plant in UAE, 15 grinding Units – 11 in India, 2 in UAE, one in Bahrain and Bangladesh each and five terminals — four in India and one in Sri Lanka.

Your Company’s performance for the half year reflects the financial results post the amalgamation of Samruddhi with your Company. The results include the performance of Samruddhi with effect from 1st July, 2010 which was the Appointed Date for the amalgamation. The operating performance for the corresponding H1FY10 has been re-casted, to include Grasim’s Cement Business performance for a like-to-like comparison and are strictly not comparable with the corresponding period of the previous year.

Your Company produced 13.24 MMT (12.88 MMT) cement in H1FY11 registering a growth of 3%. Effective capacity utilisation was at 78% on and expanded capacity. Its total sales volume increased from 13.96 MMT to 14.21 MMT. Domestic sales volume grew by 6%.

Net Sales stood at ₹ 5,005 crores (₹ 5,555 crores). Profit before Interest, Depreciation and Tax at ₹ 930 crores (₹ 1,935 crores) and Profit after Tax at ₹ 359 crores (₹ 1,049 crores) were lower by 52% and 66% respectively.

Notes:

1. The Scheme of Amalgamation ("the Scheme") of Samruddhi Cement Limited ("Samruddhi") with the Company has been sanctioned by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court on 11/06/2010 and by the Hon'ble Gujarat High Court on 01/07/2010. The Scheme became effective from 01/08/2010 and is operative from the Appointed Date i.e. 01/07/2010. The results for the period ended 30/09/2010 are inclusive of Samruddhi from the Appointed date i.e. 01/07/2010

Upon effectiveness of the Scheme, the authorised Share Capital of the Company increased to ₹ 2,800,000,000, consisting of 280,000,000 equity shares of ₹ 10/- each.

In terms of the Scheme, shareholders of Samruddhi have been allotted 149,533,469 equity shares of ₹ 10/- each of the Company as fully paid-up in the ratio of 4 (four) equity shares of the Company of face value ₹ 10/- each fully paid-up for every 7 (seven) equity shares of Samruddhi of face value ₹ 5/- each fully paid-up.

2. In view of the amalgamation of Samruddhi with the Company w.e.f. 01/07/2010, the figures for the three months and six months ended on 30/09/2010 are strictly not comparable with the corresponding period of the previous year. 3. The ESOS Compensation Committee has on 07/09/2010 allotted 920 equity shares of ₹ 10/- each of the Company to option grantees pursuant to the exercise of stock options under the Company's Employee Stock Option Scheme – 2006.
4. The paid-up equity share capital of the Company increased from 124,487,079 equity shares of ₹ 10/- each to 274,021,468 equity shares of ₹ 10/- each as a result of the allotment of equity shares in terms of the Scheme of Amalgamation ("the Scheme") and exercise of stock options under the Company's Employees Stock Option Scheme - 2006.
5. The Company's wholly-owned subsidiary 'UltraTech Cement Middle East Investments Limited' has completed the acquisition of ETA Star Cement and has acquired management control of its operations in the UAE, Bahrain and Bangladesh.

7. The Company is engaged in one business segment viz. Cement. The Company's manufacturing operations are solely situated in India.
8. The figures of the previous period have been regrouped wherever necessary.
9. The Company received 1 investor complaint during the quarter, which has been attended to. No complaints were pending at the beginning and at the end of the quarter.
10. The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their meetings held on 26/10/2010. The Statutory Auditors have carried out a limited review of the above results as required under Clause 41 of the listing agreement with the stock exchanges.

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
